

TRAVELING EASTBOUND

From I-264 East toward Norfolk/Virginia Beach

- Exit 2-A at Greenwood Drive and turn right at the base of the exit. Proceed on Greenwood Drive for 1.4 miles, then turn right on Victory Boulevard and follow for 3.3 miles. Turn right on Elm Avenue and proceed onto the Bridge to I-464.
- Exit 3 at Victory Boulevard and turn right at the base of the exit. Follow Victory Boulevard for 3.8 miles to Elm Avenue. Turn right and proceed onto the Bridge to I-464.
- Exit 4 at Portsmouth Boulevard and proceed for 1.4 miles. Turn right on Frederick Boulevard/US 17 and follow .7 mile to George Washington Highway. Turn left and follow for .4 mile to Elm Avenue. Turn right and follow 1 mile to the Bridge to I-464.
- Exit 5 at Frederick Boulevard and turn slightly right at the base of the exit. Proceed .7 mile and turn left on George Washington Highway. Follow for .4 mile to Elm Avenue. Turn right and follow 1 mile to the Bridge to I-464.
- Exit 7-A at Effingham Street and merge right onto Effingham Street. Proceed for 1.4 miles and turn left on Elm Avenue, following it 1 mile onto the Bridge to I-464.

From I-664 South

• Exit 14 at Military Highway and turn left at the base of the exit. Proceed on US-13 for 3.8 miles to George Washington Highway/US-17. Turn left and follow 1.8 miles to Victory Boulevard. Turn right and follow for 1.8 miles to Elm Avenue. Turn right and proceed onto the Bridge to I-464.

TRAVELING WESTBOUND

From I-264 West toward Portsmouth/Suffolk

- Exit 13-A at Military Highway and proceed for 2 miles to Indian River Road. Turn right and follow for 3 miles to Wilson Road. Turn left and proceed for 1.9 miles into Chesapeake along Poindexter Street and across I-464 onto the Bridge.
- Exit 11-A at Campostella Road and loop back around onto Campostella Road. Follow across the river and turn right on Wilson Road. Proceed for 1.9 miles into Chesapeake along Poindexter Street and across I-464 onto the Bridge.

From Interstate 64

- Exit 286-A at Indian River Road. Head west and proceed for 4.1 miles to Wilson Road. Turn left and proceed for 1.9 miles into Chesapeake along Poindexter Street and across I-464 onto the Bridge.
- Exit 291-A at I-464. Head North toward Norfolk. Follow for 3.9 miles and take exit 4-B at Poindexter Street. Loop around and proceed onto the Bridge.
- Exit 296 at George Washington Highway and turn left onto George Washington Highway/US-17. Proceed for 2.7 miles to Victory Boulevard. Turn right and follow for 1.8 miles to Elm Avenue. Turn right and proceed onto the Bridge to I-464.
- Exit 297 at Military Highway and turn left at the light. Proceed on US-13 for 1.3 miles to George Washington Highway/US-17. Turn left and follow 1.8 miles to Victory Boulevard. Turn right and follow for 1.8 miles to Elm Avenue. Turn right and proceed onto the Bridge to I-464.

Passenger vehicles and motorcycles pay the lowest toll with an E-ZPass. Multi-axle vehicles are tolled at rates based on the time of the trip. Visit www.SNJB.net for a complete schedule of current toll rates for all vehicle types.

E-ZPass is valid for travel in 16+ states and can be securely linked to your credit card for automatic payment processing. To register for an E-ZPass account, visit www.EZPassVA.com, call toll-free #877/762-7824 or stop by one of their office or retail locations. A list of participating retailers and locations is available on their website.

No E-ZPass, no problem! Our Pay-by-Plate rates include a small processing fee, and all trips are invoiced by mail approximately 30 days after initial travel. All customer notices are mailed to the



address provided by the DMV for the vehicle's registered owner.

Some drivers may prefer to process toll payments via mobile phone using one of our partners such as GoToll or Slora. Pre-registration is required for each program, and additional fees apply to the SNJB's published toll rates.
