



Final Winner Selected in SNJB Photo Contest

(Chesapeake, VA – February 11, 2015) The South Norfolk Jordan Bridge has selected the final Quarterly Winner in its Photography Contest. On November 30, 2014, Virginia Beach freelance photographer Yuzhu Zheng snapped a view of the bridge not often seen by its drivers, but a soft and engaging scene that features one of its legendary curves as viewed from the Pedestrian Walkway. Zheng's winning image, along with three others, will be included in a set of commemorative notecards and featured in SNJB marketing materials.

About the SNJB

The 5,375' long South Norfolk Jordan Bridge is two-lane, fixed span, high-rise toll bridge over the Southern Branch of the Elizabeth River. On the west side of the river, the bridge ties into existing Elm Avenue and Victory Boulevard in Portsmouth. On the east side, it connects to Poindexter Street and provides seamless access to I-464 in Chesapeake. The privately-funded bridge features two 12' wide traffic lanes, two 8' wide shoulders and a pedestrian sidewalk separated from traffic by a concrete barrier. A fully-electronic video capture system uses E-Z Pass to maximize convenience for users, but is not required for travel.
